Skills we will be working on:



From 6 – 12 months

- standing, holding on
- making eye contact and smiling
- Holding objects using palmer grasp
- clapping hands
- waving or responding to bye-bye
- playing simple “Peek-a-Boo” games
- Walking independently

From 12 to 18 months



- throwing a ball
- “dancing” to music
- pointing to familiar things
- using pincer grasp to pick
- drink from a cup
- practicing to use a spoon during lunch
- pointing to some body parts
- using gestures and words to communicate

Let's TALK and READ!

Have conversations together. Your baby loves interacting with you. Describe what you are doing. Use short sentences. Label objects. This develops their vocabulary. Provide positive reinforcement. Show your excitement when they use a new word! Read books to them. Point to pictures and label them. This is a good way to develop their interest in books.
