Reading Tips for Parents and educators

- Read together every day. Read to your child every day. Give everything a name. Build your child's vocabulary by talking about interesting words and objects.
- Say how much you enjoy reading.
- Read with fun in your voice.
- Know when to stop.
- Be interactive.
- Read it again and again.
- Talk about writing, too.
