Skills we will be Working On

Language Skills

- Encouraging full three to four word sentences
- Begin to name the letters in the first name

Math Skills

- Learning the concept of two eg. Please bring me two crayons or two cars
- Filling, pouring and emptying containers

Motor Skills

- Practice fine motor skills by helping to set the table during mealtimes
- Practice alternating steps

Self Help Skills

- Practice pulling pants up/down during washroom routine
- Hanging up all belongings on own hook

Science Skills

- Mixing colours and seeing new ones
- Discovering and labelling

Social Skills

- Practice turn taking “first your turn then my turn”
- Learning how to move from one activity to another during transition times
