- self- help skills removing mitten, hat



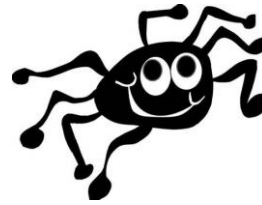
Important January Dates

Itsy-Bitsy Spider

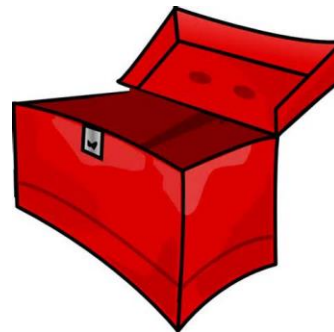
The itsy-bitsy spider
