Skills We Will Be Working On

Pre- Reading and Pre- Math

- Continue to practice reciting their first name
- Identifying colours using blocks
- Counting from 1-5 using animals

Social skills

- Listening to their teachers
- Beginning to label their emotions
- Playing simple games in pairs, such as “row row, row your boat”



Motor skills

- Jumping with 2 feet together
- Kicking a ball to a friend
- Practicing rolling dough into a small ball

Self- Help

- Dry hands independently after washing
- Pulling up their pants after toileting
- Practice putting their shoes on

Ideas for You to Do At Home

Have your child practice colouring or scribbling on paper that are different colours, sizes and shapes. This will help your child enhance their colour and shape recognition while learning to stay within the boundaries of the paper.

Did You Know That...

When children work on puzzles, they develop hand – eye – coordination and fine motor skills. Children are required to manipulate various shapes and place them in the corresponding slots. At the same cognitive table children also learn about colour matching, shape recognition and problem solving.
