### Skills We Will Be Working On:

#### Pre-Reading and Pre-Math Skills

- \* practice saying their own name during Circle time
- \* practice labeling basic shapes and primary colours
- \* practice using sign language for milk, more and “I Love You”

#### Motor Skills

- \* practice catching a medium ball
- \* practice snipping with scissors
- \* lace a spool or large bead using gyp



#### Social Skills

- \* practice asking questions “What” and “Where”
- \* practice to turn taking with our friends
- \* play cooperatively with other children

#### Self-Help Skills

- \* practice to pour milk without spilling
- \* work on wiping their their own nose
