Be sure to check your child's cubby for appropriate indoor and outdoor clothing, shoes and boots.

8 things you might not know about maintaining your child's Dental hygiene



- Your child's mouth should be cleaned even before your child gets teeth (cleaning gums with wet washcloth, never use toothpaste until your child has teeth)
- your child's teeth should be brushed twice daily with a soft bristle brush
 - children under 3 should have their parents brush their teeth, the use of fluoridated toothpaste should be used in minimal amounts (size of a grain of rice).
 - take your child to the dentist for an assessment
 - Replace toothbrushes every 3-4 months
 - Children under 6 should be supervised to prevent excess toothpaste being swallowed (this may result in dental fluorosis). Between ages 3 and 6 a small green pea amount is used making sure to spit it out.
 - don't forget to floss your child's teeth after brushing
 - make sure the last brushing is just before bed
