## **Skills We Will Be Working On**

### Cognition:

- Recognizing and practicing to print the letters of our names.
- Naming and drawing different shapes
- Counting from 1 – 20.

### Social:

- Waiting for our turn
- Co- operating with peers when playing
- Interacting positively during group experiences

### Emotional:

- Identifying our emotions
- Expressing negative emotions in ways that do not harm others

### Language and Literacy:

- Choosing to spend time with books
- Requesting specific stories, poems, songs

### Physical:

- Using open –ended materials to move about, build and construct
- Gaining the ability to control our movements

## **How does Learning Happens**
