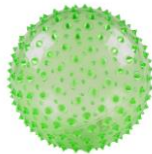

## **Skills we will be working on:**

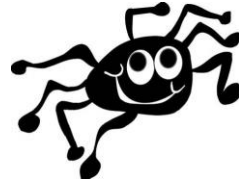
- crawling/ pulling self to stand

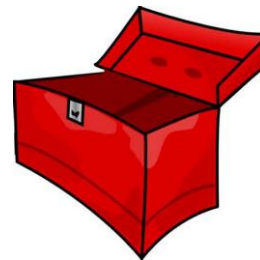


## **Itsy-Bitsy Spider**
