***Things you can work on at home with your children:***

***Try to model sharing and turn taking. Encourage your child to use words like “please, stop, I don’t like it.”***



### Pre- Reading and Pre- Math

- Practice saying their names and their friends in the class
- Continue to practice counting from 1 – 3 objects
- Attempting to say “Mine” if someone takes their toy away

### Social skill

- **Practice using gentle hands with friends**
- **Practice identifying primary colours (red, blue yellow)**
- **Practice labeling objects using one word**

### Motor skills

- Placing one block on top another to balance
- Stringing large beads
- Standing and balancing on one foot

### Self- Help

- Continue to practice putting our shoes on
- Practice pulling their pants down and up at diapering time
- Continue to encourage children to try different types of food
