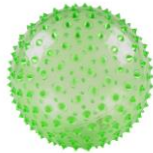
Skills we will be working on:

- respond to simple requests

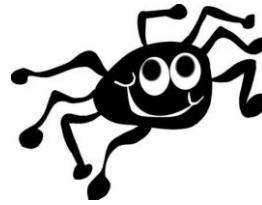


Reminders:

Ideas to do at home

Use nature to create art.

Go for a walk and collect different leaves.

Using glue, you can help your infant put glue on and then let them place the leaves down on the paper.

Using a small piece of tape, you can tape down your leaf and let your infant paint over. Then take off the leaf and observe the print left behind.
