Nov. 14th Diwali Festival of Lights

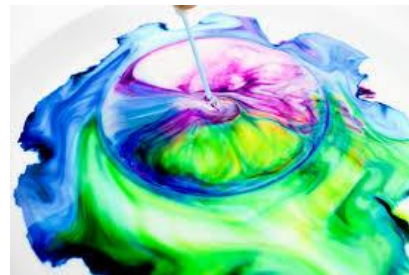
Fun ideas to do at home with infants
