Math Skills

- Create and repeat shapes and patterns
- Concept of different sizes
- Sorting objects, pictures and things into groups and/or along a continuum

Motor Skills

- Practice eye – hand co-ordination by lacing beads
- Practice using our pincer grasp when engaged in creative experiences

Self Help Skills

- Practice fasteners e.g. zippers, buttons & snaps

Science Skills

- Discover colours and what new colours are made when mixed together
- Identify cause and reaction when liquids mix together

Social Skills

- Recognize own belongings and work
- Play with others who have differing abilities and characteristics
- Respond with appropriate emotional energy in keeping with the situation
