Figure 1. Learning and development happens within the context of relationships among children, families, educators, and their environments.

Children are competent, capable of complex thinking, curious, and rich in potential.

Families are experts on their children. They are the first and most powerful influence on children's learning, development, health, and well-being.

Educators are competent and capable, curious, and rich in experience. They are knowledgeable, caring, reflective, and resourceful professionals. They collaborate with others to create engaging environments and experiences.
