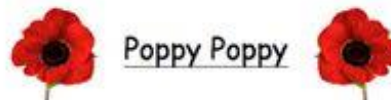
Nov. 11th- Remembrance Day

know?

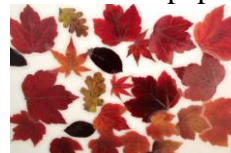
That peace on earth should

Ideas to do at home:

Use nature to create art.

Go for a walk and collect different leaves.

Use a glue (you can help to put glue on the paper) and let your child place the leaves down on the paper.



Use a paint and help your infant paint the leaves and press them down on a paper to create a print.



Use small pieces of tape and leaves (you can tape down your leaf) and help your infant paint over. Then take off the leaf and tape and there will be a print left behind.
