Skills we are working on:

Social Skills

Keeping social distance while playing with/beside our peers
Building on our empathy skills to encourage others to play (2.3 self-esteem)

Pre-reading Skills

Tracing over letters that correspond with the first letter of our names (3.1 letter recognition)
Using letter and word puzzles to categorize familiar words (3.13 matching spoken words with written words)

Self Help Skills:

Independently using a tissue & washing hands (4.1 self-regulation, 4.2 problem solving)
Practicing covering our cough and sneeze.
Practicing washing and sanitizing hands.

Motor Skills:

Using sleds to pull and push in the snow (5.2 gross motor: riding)
Building snowmen and snowballs to play with (5.2 gross motor: throwing)



Math Skills:

Observing different colours of leaves (4.14 comparing quantities)
