Skills we are working on:

- Enhance walking skills

Ideas to do at home:

Play a game “What is inside”.

Find a Box that has a large enough opening on the top to place different types of toys in it. Place a toy inside and ask “What is inside?” (You may have to model to your infant how to open the box and pull out the toy) Allow them to open the box and find out what is inside. Once they find out what is inside tell your baby what it is. I.e. Ball, Teddy Bear, Shoe. Repeat with different items.
